Here are some great tips on how to apply your favorite lip gloss to achieve that lustrous, full volume pout!

Right Application of Lip Gloss First thing first, apply your lip gloss on properly. Instead of putting gloss on like you do lipstick (from left to right, top to bottom with a smack!), first apply gloss to the middle of your bottom lip only. Rub lips together. This will keep gloss from going on too thickly and getting goopy on you.

I want to Use Lip Gloss Over Lipstick! If you wish to give your current lip stick color a mood lift, it is a great idea to slide some yummy lip gloss over your applied lip stick. I love the look of just a bit of gloss over a neutral lipstick. Again, dab just a bit in the center of lips and smooth out from there. This method of smoothing out the lip gloss from the center will help you from applying too the lip gloss on too thickly.

Lip Gloss too Sticky? Did you accidentally apply a little too much gloss? No problem! There is a very simple solution to this. All you do is just to smack your lips between a tissue paper, just like you would lipstick! There you go, all is good to go again!

Defining The Perfect Lips

Choosing the right makeup may be something of a challenge for many women. If you look around, you will probably see women who have on foundation that is either too dark or too light for their coloring. An often overlooked area that can make a difference is the lips. Because they are not comfortable choosing or wearing lipstick, some women leave their lips bare or stick with just lip-gloss. For most women, both can be a mistake.

If not applied correctly, lip-gloss can be a terrible choice. If the gloss has a tint to it, it is important to keep it only on the lips. Here is a great women related website

Many will accidentally let it smear past the lips making the lips look greasy due to the shininess of the gloss. If the lady chooses not to wear anything on her lips, her mouth may just blend in with the rest of her facial skin.

Most decide not to use lipstick because it runs, but that can easily be fixed by using a lip pencil that matches the shade of the lipstick. By outlining the lip with the pencil and letting it dry, it will keep the lipstick that is then applied over it within the lip area instead of bleeding over to the edges. Of course, to keep a fresh look, you must apply the lipstick again after eating or drinking since these activities will rub or smudge the lipstick off.

If you don't want to use lipstick with a lip pencil, you can resort to just gloss. However, make sure to choose a lip-gloss that is not colored. If it does smear a little, a clear gloss will not show up as badly as a tinted gloss. Since the lips can be sunburned, it is a good idea to use some type of lip covering that has an SPF of at least 15 built into the product. If you will be outdoors for a long time, it is recommended that you use a lip balm with the sunscreen to keep the lips moist and protected.

A balm will last longer since it goes deeper into the skin making it last longer. You can wear a balm with sunscreen in it under your lipstick to have the best of both. To maintain protection, you will need to reapply the balm just as you would lipstick. Be careful when wearing lip-gloss since most do not contain a sunscreen. It can be used over the lip balm, however.

How To Apply Lip Gloss Correctly!

Many think that lip-gloss should be reserved for teen girls since they don't usually need darker shades of color. A gloss can highlight their natural lip color without making them like they are trying to be older than they are.
