How to Avoid Speed Traps

If you have ever driven a car, then you have probably been stopped—or almost stopped—for speeding. Regardless if you have a lead foot or were just in the wrong place at the wrong time, speeding tickets can wreck havoc on your driving record and bank account. From hefty fines to points registered against your driving record that can dramatically influence your insurance payments, speeding tickets are detrimental in all aspects.

Many speeding tickets are issued in so-called speed traps, where police officers or state troopers effectively hide their cars and lie in wait for speedy passers-by. Also, many city, state, and country roads have varying speed limits that can serve as excellent speed traps for law enforcement patrols waiting to issue speeding tickets to drivers unaware of the correct speed limit.

The best way to avoid speeding tickets is to avoid speed traps all together. There are four main tips for avoiding speed traps that should allow you to protect your wallet and your driving records from hefty fines or mars on a perfect record that can (and often will) directly affect the quality and cost of your car insurance policy.

1.) Watch your speed.

This may seem to be a no-brainer, but the first tip is straight forward: drivers that do not speed are not issued speeding tickets. Keep an eye on your speedometer or set the cruise control on long trips to avoid going over the speed limit, thus avoiding costly fines. Also, the faster your drive, the greater the stopping distance and the less control you have over your vehicle. Each year, countless car crashes could easily be avoided by not speeding.

2.) Know the speed limit.

Again, knowing the speed limit may be quite simple, but it can easily allow you to avoid speeding tickets. Quite often, speed traps are set where the limit rapidly changes or suddenly plummets, leaving unaware drivers zipping along and at risk for being pulled over for a speeding location. Keep a careful eye out for posted speed limit signs so that you are always aware of the correct speed for which your

vehicle should be traveling.

3.) Do your homework.

Many websites and resources are available for individuals interested in finding speed traps in their area or along their route. This is especially crucial for individuals embarking on road trips, allowing drivers to become somewhat familiar with unknown areas. Consider visiting the World Wide Web and conducting a quick and easy search for popular websites and forums where fellow travelers converse about speed traps in their area. Some towns are so well known that motorist associations like AAA have flagged them along popular traveler's routes.

4.) Invest in a radar detector.

For motorists who still find themselves at risk for being caught in speed traps, consider investing in a

radar detector. This simple electronic device is easily installed and can immediately notify the driver when the device picks up a radar gun in the area. Once you are aware of the police officer or state patrol who has stationed themselves in a speed trap, you can quickly and easily adjust your speed and avoid a ticket. Radar detectors use traditional radio wave technology or a more advanced laser technology in order to detect radar guns that are currently in use. However, it is critical you check the legality of radar detectors in your state, since several states have determined use and even possession of such a device is illegal. If you are caught possessing or using a radar detector in these states, the fines can be a great deal larger than those fines associated with speeding tickets.

How to Choose a Radar Jamming Device

Radar detectors come in all shapes and sizes, but may not be effective enough to work to protect you against costly speeding tickets. Many motorists choose to invest in radar jamming devices instead of radar detectors that may leave your car unaware of potential speed traps, police officers, or state troopers waiting to ticket speeding.

Radar detectors do just that—detect radar beams that are being distributed from the radar guns of police officers or state troopers. If these radar guns are incompatible with the specific brand or type of radar detector your purchase, you will be left unaware of potential speed traps. Furthermore, radar detectors can be tricked by other items that are not meant to detect speeders. These false alarms can be annoying and still leave you open for potential speeding tickets that can not only wreck havoc on your wallet, but also your driving record and car insurance policy.

How to Avoid Speed Traps

Radar jamming devices, again, work as named. These devices work to literally jam radar guns, so that police officers or state troopers will be unable to directly pinpoint your speed. Instead of radar detectors that can be tricked or evaded by the radar guns, a radar jamming device has the capability to work against the majority of radar guns used by law enforcement officials on the highways and roadways of this country.

Remember, even though your vehicle is equipped with a radar jamming device, you may still be at risk for speeding tickets. Although the radar gun of a police officer or state trooper may be jammed, most law enforcement officials are able to identify if a vehicle is speeding excessively, which can still result in a ticket. Furthermore, radar jamming devices may allow you certain leeway with law enforcement officials, but you should still abide by the posted speed limit in order to operate your vehicle in the safest manner possible.

If you are in the market for a radar jamming device, begin by setting an approximate budget for your purchase. This budget will allow you to easily find a radar jamming device that will work for your specific circumstances. Keep in mind that top of the line electronics may not necessarily be the best option for you. Look to purchase a quality piece of electronic equipment that will not break the bank.

Since a radar jamming device is a piece of electronic equipment, you should be sure to find a quality product that comes with a reputable warranty. This warranty will allow you to protect your investment in the event of malfunction or accident, so that your device can be repaired or completely replaced at little or no charge.

Ensure the radar jamming device your plan to purchase has an adequate range. Make an inquiry to the distance of the device so that your radar jamming device will be able to protect you from radar guns around every turn. Furthermore, ensure your device will work in a variety of environments, including sun, rain, and even snow.

Finally, when choosing a radar jamming device, you should be completely aware of the legal laws of your state or city. Just as with radar detectors, radar jamming devices are illegal in some areas and many states have completely blocked the use of these anti-radar items. If radar detectors or radar jamming devices are considered illegal in your state, motorists with a forbidden device in their vehicle

can rack up a phenomenal fee. If your state has anti radar detectors or radar jamming devices, be sure to abide by the laws and avoid purchasing or installing either of these electronic items for your own good.
