Information On Adult Diapers

Adult diapers are made up of continuous layers of cloth or towel fabric, or such a material that can absorb liquid. The following are some examples of when adult diapers are used:

- Security guards who have to remain on duty for a very long period of time.
- Drivers who are forced to do non-stop driving.
- They are also suitable for astronauts during the time they are in spacecraft.

- People who are suffering from injuries, and cannot move from their places.

Cloth diapers are comparatively cheaper than other types of diapers, and they can also be re-used. They are more user-friendly, as they are made up of cotton fabric and are comfortable to wear. These diapers are usually best for people who are mentally or physically disturbed, as they are cheap and biodegradable.

Another type of adult diaper is the disposable diaper that is made up of waterproof cloth on its exterior, and moisture wicking cloth inside. There are many layers of tissue papers inside the moisture wicking cloth, and they are able to soak almost 90cc of liquid. Disposable diapers are more popular than cloth diapers because they can easily be disposed of, and you do not have to wash them again and again. Disposable diapers are made up of such a material that provides full dryness to your skin and keeps it free from rashes. Because of their moisture wicking layer, they are more comfortable to wear. Disposable diapers are more costly than cloth diapers.

Disposable diapers have eliminated the market of the cloth diaper due to their convenience. However, they take a huge amount of processing and their material remains as it is in landfills for various years. This is the reason that some countries have banned the dumping of untreated waste in landfills. Rather, they are incinerated as little residue is left in this way.

These disposable diapers contain various chemicals that are obtained inadvertently during their production, and also deliberately to increase the absorbing capacity. Although it works efficiently to keep the skin dry, it leads to irritation of the skin. But since they can be simply thrown away, people have ignored this disadvantage and to this date, disposable diapers are dominating the market.

Recent techniques have launched hybrid reusable diapers; they are made up of a fashionable pant, which can be reused. These diapers are made up of a material that is fully flushable and compostable to give extra care and comfort to adults as well as to babies.

And The Debate Continues – Cloth vs. Disposable Diapers

Cloth or disposable? Which one is better? This debate has been going on since the 70s and 80s. And it continues today with each side saying the other is the superior product. But cloth diapers are making a comeback with new flushable liners.

Cloth diapers are what all mothers used until disposable diapers became mainstream. These diapers are not as convenient or easy to dispose. But, at one time, cloth was all a mother had to work with. Today, cloth diapers are not our mothers diapers. There are new, flushable liners that allow mothers to easily flush the waste down the toilet. Many now have velcro closure tabs; no more large safety pins!

Disposable diaper history starts in 1942 in Sweden with Pauli Ström. The first disposables had an inner lining made up of many layers of tissue paper. They showed up in the marketplace during the 1960s after pulp mill replaced tissue paper. At that time they were fairly expensive. Today's disposables have an even more absorbent inner layer that they are more convenient than before. Even though these diapers have only been on the market for 40 years, we are going to feel the effects for thousands of years.

And those effects is one of the biggest issues of this debate. Those who believe cloth is better because disposable diapers are not very biodegradable. With the type of materials used and the amount of processing they go through, disposables remain in landfills around 500 years. Many countries throughout the world have banned leaving untreated human waste in landfills. And so, they began incinerating the diapers, which leaves almost no residue. Still, not every country is taking these measures.

Another point of contention is cost. You have to take these questions into consideration: how many diapers am I using per month; how much am I spending on our diaper service; how much water and electricity am I using to launder the diapers? There are a lot of valid points on each side for cost. To use strictly disposables, you may spend from \$50 to \$80 per month; to use cloth diapers and a service, you may spend the same. But to use cloth and launder them yourself, you may spend \$25 to \$60 per month.

It is all a matter of choice. Some parents use cloth diapers while at home and disposables when they go out. Others use strictly one or the other. Ultimately, we parents have to make choices based on what we think is the right thing to do.
