. Instead, they are

proudly displayed hanging on a wall or sitting in a stand in plain view. In this way the family can keep the prints and brag about them to everyone. Family members could even give this as a baby gift to the expecting parents.

The plaques can be made in a variety of configurations. You may choose a small plaque that has only the hands or the feet. However, you can choose a larger plaque that can fit both the hands and feet. Or even better, you can include all of the children's prints in one plaque if you missed out doing this with older siblings. Another sweet memory would be have both the parents' and the baby's hand prints on the same plaque.

Another unique memory option is a three-dimensional representation of your baby's hand or foot. By placing the hand or foot into a jelly that sets in just seconds, the artist has a mold by which to create a cast. The cast will be the identical replication of your baby's hand or foot, and you can have it made in brass, silver, glass, or gold. You don't have to let time steal those precious memories; capture them forever in prints.
